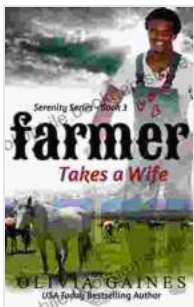


Farmer Takes a Wife: The Serenity of Rural Life

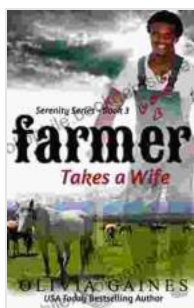

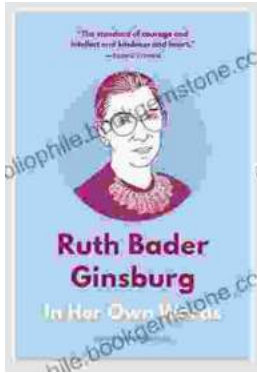

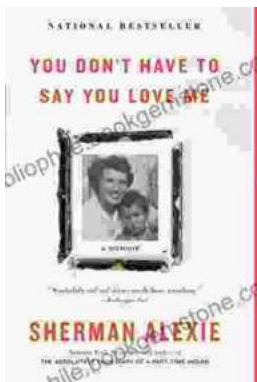
