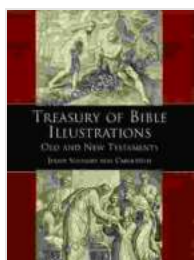


Pentecost, illustrated in the contemporary style.

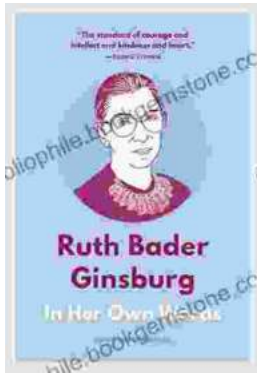

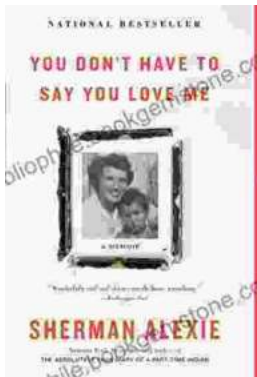
