Reviews

Rogue is an effective ghost thriller that benefits from a strong cast and creepy atmosphere. However, its lack of originality and poor character

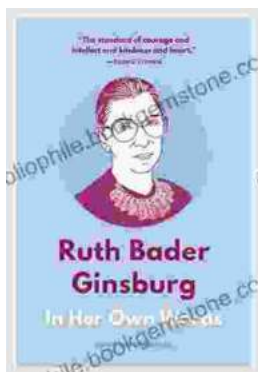

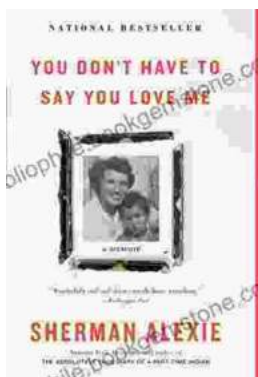
