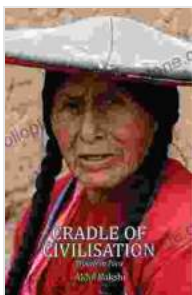
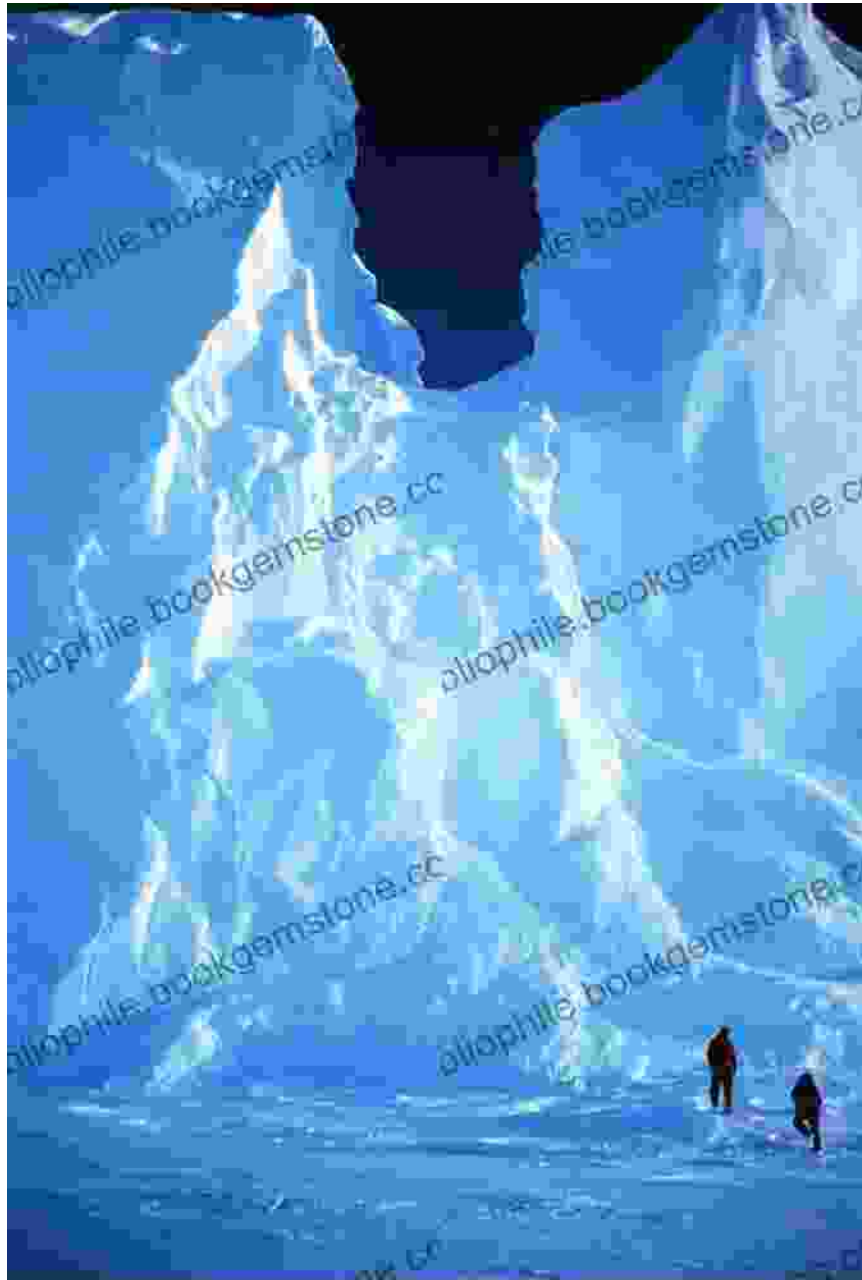

Planning Your Trip

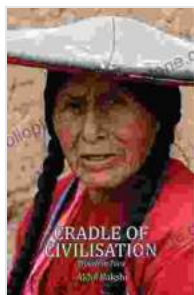

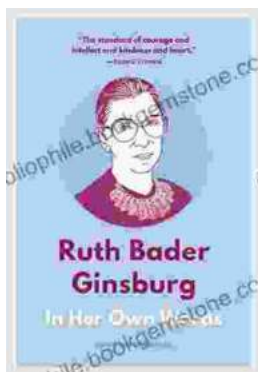

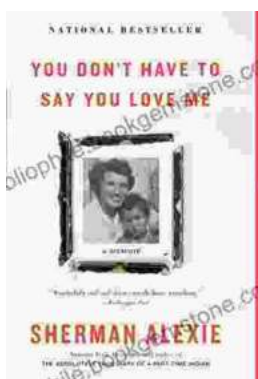
